

TCC meetings on the move from Vikings

THE Tuggeranong Community Council (TCC) will be changing the venue, nights and times for its meeting.

President of the TCC, Darryl Johnston, told members at last week's monthly meeting that the council needed to find a new home due to the fact their current meeting place, the Vikings Club in Greenway, would be undergoing extensive renovations in the coming months.

While the council meetings could take place at the club while the renovations were taking place, they would need to be on a different night and would be

required to move to new premises when the renovations were complete.

Mr Johnston said a number of venues had been considered by the TCC executive, with the most suitable being the Southern Cross Club. However, Thursday night meetings could not be guaranteed through the entire year.

The Vikings Club in Erindale was mentioned as an alternative site and a request was made to further investigate its feasibility as a meeting place.

When put to a vote, moving to the Southern Cross Club, with meetings now on Tuesday nights,

was passed 15 to nine. The TCC will now put a request in to the Southern Cross Club manager to finalise the move.

Meanwhile, the formation of the TCC sub-committees are off to a slow start.

Three people have put their hands up to be part of the youth/senior citizens/health, planning and development, and environment committees, while only one person has so far signed up for the transport committee.
